WOODBIDGE, VA – May 7, 2025 – Prince William Water is accepting applications for its summer 2025 Water Academy. This three-session educational program is designed for adults and high school seniors who live, work or study in Prince William County.

The Water Academy offers an immersive educational experience that includes a look at the science and technology behind water and wastewater treatment, the opportunity to learn from Prince William Water's leadership team and a behind-the-scenes tour of the H.L. Mooney Advanced Water Reclamation Facility. The program is filled with hands-on learning activities, presentations about water quality, water conservation, source water protection, tips for Prince William Water customers and more.
