6. **Question**: Is a class c license required or just State corporate commission?

Response: A valid Virginia Class A Contractor's License and registration with the Virginia State Corporation Commission are required for this contract.

7. **Question**: Class A license is not required?

Response: See question # 6

8. **Question**: What is an example of an emergency situation that would require immediate attention in regards to painting services?

Response: An emergency requiring immediate painting services may occur when equipment or a tank is taken offline and corrosion control is needed promptly to minimize downtime.

9. **Question**: Does corrosion control include services outside of painting and surface preparation?

Response: Yes. Corrosion control can include services beyond painting and surface preparation. For example, during surface preparation, previously concealed damage may be exposed, such as areas that require patching or minor repairs to restore the integrity of the surface before protective coatings are applied.

10. **Question**: Do you provide climate controlled onsite storage for projects that require multiple days to complete?

Response: No, typically exterior surfaces requiring corrosion control are not located in climate-controlled environments; therefore, the contractor would be responsible for providing the necessary measures to maintain environmental conditions in accordance with the manufacturer's application recommendations.
