### **Project Background**


- April 1999, SA identified the need to improve water system hydraulics and reliability in the area.
- October 2012, reevaluated and relocated pumping station location.
- In late 2015, changed the construction method to design-build due to complexity of the project.
- Design/Build Agreement awarded to ACE/KCI for Preliminary Design.
  - Through 65% design and Guaranteed Maximum Price negotiations.





### Purpose of the Project

- Maintain water quality.
- Improve system hydraulics and reliability for Four Seasons and other customers.
- Provide a redundant water line into Four Seasons.
- Maintain the level of service residents receive.
- Accommodate future growth and water demands / existing system will not adequately support growth.

### **Project Status Update**

- Preliminary Design Stage and Guaranteed Maximum Price negotiations are complete.
- Final Design and Construction Stage Agreement is underway.
  - Notice to Proceed December 13, 2021.
  - Total duration 851 calendar days to final completion.
  - Permit reviews and approvals in progress.
  - On-site construction activities early Fall 2022.
  - Anticipated completion spring 2024.
- Website to be updated with adjusted completion date.



### **Upcoming Project Activities**

- Continue with ongoing permitting.
- On-site construction activities in early fall 2022.
  - Begin with temporary construction access road.
  - Installation of the water discharge main.
- Website to be updated with key milestones.
- Coordination with Community Association to identify parking locations at clubhouse.
  - Minimizes parking along Four Seasons Drive.
  - Temporary construction access road minimizes traffic disruptions within the community.



### **SA Commitments**

- To restore property affected by SA construction to original or better condition.
- Road access maintained at all times.
  - Emergency services, trash, mail, and other services.
- To continuously communicate and work with the Community Association concerning project status.
- To respond quickly to residents' concerns.



### **SA Commitments**

- Work with the Community Association to define parking and access constraints.
  - Incorporated into Design-Build Agreement.
- Daily clean-up by the Design-Builder is required.
- Service Authority Inspector on site daily and as necessary.
- Arcadis: Construction Manager / Project Representative
  - On-site for the duration of the project.
