

**Water Storage Tank Rehabilitation CIP

Project Summary**

Project Description:

This Prince William County Service Authority project consists of rehabilitation of the Interstate Water Storage Tank at 16751 Interstate Drive in Dumfries.

Purpose of the Project:

The purpose of this project is to extend the life of the water storage tank and to install a mixing system that will help maintain drinking water quality for area residents.

Scope of Work:

The rehabilitation project includes the following components:

- Sandblasting and painting the interior and exterior of the tank;
- Placement of a water mixer in the tank to maintain water quality;
- General repairs and improvements to bring the tank into compliance with the latest Occupational Safety and Health Administration code requirements.

Project Duration:

The project is anticipated to begin in February 2022 and to be complete by the end of June 2022.
