
# Occoquan River Crossing Public Meeting March 24, 2021

#### Fairfax Water – Who We Are

- Chartered in 1957 by the State Corporation Commission as a public, non-profit water utility
- Governed by a 10-member Board of Directors
- Serves nearly 2 million people in Northern Virginia
  - (Retail) Fairfax County and Cities of Falls Church and Fairfax
  - (Wholesale) Prince William County Service Authority (PWCSA) and Virginia-American Water (V-AW)

## Project Background

- Fairfax Water currently serves eastern Prince William County via two parallel water transmission mains crossing under the Occoquan River
- Higher delivery pressures required to meet future demands exceed limitations of existing river crossing
- Project initiated to meet future demands and improve resiliency and reliability of service to eastern Prince William County



#### **Project Coordination**

■ Fairfax Water, PWCSA and V-AW worked closely on preliminary engineering/conceptual development Several "functional options" were evaluated and preferred option agreed to by all three systems Project will enhance reliability and redundancy for PWCSA and V-AW customers



#### **Project Elements**

#### River Crossing

Installation of dual 42-inch water mains tunnelled beneath the Occoquan River

#### Tanyard Hill Road

Replacement of 700 linear feet of 24-inch water main and interconnection to 36-inch water main

#### Horner Road

Interconnection between existing 24-inch and 36-inch water mains **Fairfax Water**


