

**Water Storage Tank Rehabilitation CIP WST-110
Project Summary**

Project Description:

This Prince William County Service Authority project consists of the rehabilitation of the Braemar Water Storage Tank at 9933 Broadsword Drive in Bristow.

Purpose of the Project:

The purpose of this project is to extend the life of the water tank and install a mixing system that will help maintain drinking water quality for area residents.

Scope of Work:

The construction consists of:

- Sandblasting and painting of the interior and exterior of the tank;
- Placement of a water mixer in the tank to maintain water quality;
- General repairs and improvements to bring the tank into compliance with the latest Occupational Safety and Health Administration code requirements;
- Placement of Prince William County Government wordmark and Prince William County Service Authority logos on either side of the tank; and
- Temporary construction of a telecommunications pole next to the tank;

Construction has been completed.
