

# WONDERING ABOUT YOUR WELL WATER?

THE H<sub>2</sub>O QUALITY LAB, A DIVISION OF THE PRINCE WILLIAM COUNTY SERVICE AUTHORITY, **CAN TEST THE QUALITY OF YOUR WATER.**



The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) recommends testing your well annually for total coliform bacteria, nitrates and pH levels. Test fees range from \$15 to \$32. Water sample collection fees may apply.

The EPA also recommends testing your well water for the following reasons if:

-  There are known problems with ground water or drinking water in your area.
-  You replace or repair any part of your well system.
-  Conditions near your well have changed significantly due to flooding, land disturbances, or new construction or industrial activity.
-  You notice a change in your water quality (e.g. odor, color, taste).
